
Undefeated and Undeniable:MRC's Spotless Legacy in Exposing Media Bias

At MRC, we've kicked up a hornet's nest, and we're proud of it. We have stood as a watchdog over the press for 38 years, documenting bias the moment it appears and breaking the media's monopoly on the narrative.

In all that time, not one of our studies has been debunked. Our methodology is solid. Our details are airtight. We have to be flawless, or we lose credibility — and we've never lost it. That's not just about us; it's about staying true to you and the fight for an honest media.

Take Stephen Colbert. His left-wing "comedy" routine was costing CBS \$40 million a year before he got the axe.

In late July, we published a study showing that since September 2022, Colbert had on 176 left-leaning guests and

exactly one Republican — Liz Cheney. The *New York Post* put our findings on the front page.

That drove the Left nuts. Colbert's former producer, Pete Dominick, lashed out on a podcast, calling MRC "discredited," "conspiratorial," and worse. He even claimed Colbert invited conservatives such as JD Vance but they refused to appear because Colbert is "too good at embarrassing them."

Here's the truth:

- Our study tracked who actually appeared on air, not who may or may not have been invited because that's all viewers see.
- 2) Trump's 2015 Colbert appearance has nothing to do with our current count, which began in 2022.
- Colbert himself recently admitted he won't host Trump or politicians he thinks "don't honestly represent what they believe."
- Contrast that with Bill Maher, who says Republicans love doing his show while Democrats avoid it.
- 5) And yes, we were generous. We counted Liz Cheney as the lone "Republican" guest, even though most conservatives would say she no longer fits the bill.

If critics want to dispute our interpretation, fine — but they can't dismiss the raw numbers. The reality is late-night TV has become an echo chamber, shutting out conservative voices altogether.

NewsBusters exists to expose that bias with facts, not fiction. If the Left is irritated, good. That means the truth is cutting through.

Bozell Warns Administration of Al Bias


MRC President David Bozell has sounded the alarm that the garbage-in/garbage-out nature of artificial intelligence bots threatens their potential to revolutionize how Americans get their information.

In letters to Russ Vought, director of the Office of Management and Budget, and Andrew Ferguson, chairman of the Federal Trade Commission, Bozell warned that top AI companies were signing data agreements with predominantly left-wing legacy media outlets and, as a result, developing responses that mirrored those outlets' bias and lies.

Bozell's letter to Vought asked him to clarify whether these contracts violated a recent executive order from President Trump. His letter to Ferguson requested that Ferguson investigate whether the AI firms' contracts constitute anti-competitive and unfair practices that could distort the marketplace.

OpenAI has trained its ChatGPT with 21 outlets deemed left-of-center, including *The Washington Post*, *The Atlantic*, *The Financial Times*, and Vox Media, and only two right-leaning outlets – the *New York Post* and Fox News. Amazon's bot uses *The New York Times*, as does the Associated Press's.

Bozell wrote that MRC research had found that AI platforms were contracting with leftist outlets 10 times as often as with those on the right. These contracts "limit competition, reinforce a single ideological perspective, and undermine the diversity of information essential to neutral AI outputs."



Will AI Summaries Spell an End to Just 'Google It'?

MRC has shown that Google's search results favor leftist outlets. With the introduction of new AI summaries, Google users may not interact with search results at all. Pew Research found that "Google users who encounter an AI summary are less likely to click on links to other websites than users who do not see one." This is especially concerning, as sources like left-leaning Wikipedia are cited twice as often by Gemini as in standard search results.

MRC Overcomes Key DC Argument

When President Trump decided to send in FBI and National Guard troops to restore safety to the nation's capital, his opponents responded that this was overkill because crime was decreasing in Washington. MRC set the record straight with "Five Facts About DC Crime That Don't Fit The Narrative."

MRC's report pointed out that Washington is fourth in the nation in homicides per capita; its murder rate is six times that of New York City, even higher than some of the world's most dangerous cities, such as Mexico City and Bogotá, Colombia.

MRC also pointed out that a DC police commander was suspended after he accused the top brass of changing crime statistics to minimize reports of violence and sentences of defendants.

"When our members respond to the scene of a felony offense where there is a victim reporting that a felony occurred, inevitably there will be a lieutenant or a captain that will show up on that scene and direct those members to take a report for a lesser offense," said Gregg Pemberton, chairman of the DC Fraternal Order of Police. "So instead of taking a report for a shooting or a stabbing or a carjacking, they will order that officer to take a report for a theft or an injured person to the hospital or a felony assault, which is not the same type of classification."

Pemberton said management would direct officers to change more violent offenses to felony assault because those are not reported to the FBI's uniform crime reporting program or the department's own crime stats, thus making it appear there are far fewer crimes than there are.

NewsBusters Celebrates 20th Anniversary!

A Mocking Flashback of the Media Madness

In August 2025, NewsBusters celebrated its 20th anniversary by sifting through a million-hour TV news archive to unearth "The Most Absurd and Obnoxious Outbursts" from leftist media types. MRC's Geoff Dickens, like a determined prospector plucking 20 specific grains of sand from the Sahara, curated the worst quotes from each year, exposing the media's true colors with biting clarity. We've highlighted some of them for you. And of note, MSNBC led the pack with 11 worst quotes.

The journey begins in 2005, with ex-CBS producer Mary Mapes defiantly insisting on *Good Morning America* that unproven Bush National Guard documents weren't forgeries, shrugging, "I don't think that's the standard." A harbinger of journalistic rot.

In 2008, Chris Matthews' infamous "thrill going up my leg" remark during Obama's primary coverage on MSNBC crystallized everything wrong with the media. His gushing, "He speaks about America in a way that has nothing to do with politics" wasn't reporting - it was worship. This seminal moment tore the mask off, revealing sycophantic cheerleading masquerading as journalism.

In 2009, Ed Schultz ranted on MSNBC's *The Ed Show* that Republicans wanted Americans "dead" for profit. "They'd rather make money off your dead corpse!" Hyperbole as

In 2011, Paul Krugman's *New York Times* blog smeared 9/11 responders such as Rudy Giuliani as "fake heroes," whining, "The memory of 9/11 has been irrevocably poisoned." His revisionist vitriol turned tragedy into a political cudgel.

Fast-forward to 2013, MSNBC's Melissa Harris-Perry declared in a *Lean Forward* spot, "**Kids belong to whole communities**," dismissing parental rights with collectivist zeal. Subtlety was never her forte.

In 2016, CNN's Van Jones wailed about a "white-lash" on election night, lamenting, "This was a white-lash against a black president." His melodramatic framing turned voters into cartoon villains.

In 2022, Don Lemon told Stephen Colbert, "I don't think we (CNN) ever were liberal," prompting a stunned "What?" from Colbert. Either Lemon's lying or he's delusional. Both are plausible.

In 2024, MSNBC's Joe Scarborough gushed on *Morning Joe*, "This version of Biden intellectually, analytically, is the best Biden ever." That one didn't age well.

Finally, in 2025, fright-wig-wearing Elie Mystal on *The Breakfast Club* trashed the U.S. Constitution as "a piece of crap," pining for South Africa's.

For 20 years, NewsBusters has been tormenting the media with its own folly and insanity. Proving the media's bias isn't just bias — it's performance art in self-parodying absurdity.





Media Ignore Gabbard's Bombshell to Protect a Narrative

The press sidesteps inconvenient stories to shield their sacred narratives, not reporting but deceiving and propagandizing. A new study from MRC reveals that ABC, CBS, and NBC devoted 2,284 minutes to the Trump-Russia collusion probe from 2016 to 2019, yet gave just 2 minutes and 17 seconds to Tulsi Gabbard's declassification bombshell. Gabbard's findings exposed Obama administration

officials crafting the Russia narrative to undermine Trump a revelation warranting massive headlines but met with silence. The networks spent 1,000 times as much airtime pushing a lie than covering its unraveling. Why? First, to protect their Democrat allies. Second, admitting the truth exposes their complicity in the hoax. The media weren't just reporting; they were active players, ignoring facts that didn't fit. If the shoe

were on the other foot and documents showed Trump sabotaging Biden, the media would erupt like an F5 tornado. But when truth dismantles their narrative, they clam up. This isn't journalism — it's selective storytelling, betraying public trust and exposing their role as propagandists masquerading

as news.

MEDIA'S DOUBLE STANDARD:

CNN and MSNBC's Distorted Gerrymandering Coverage

"Gerrymandering" originated in 1812 when Massachusetts Governor Elbridge Gerry signed a redistricting plan, twisting Senate districts to favor his Democratic-Republican Party. The Boston Gazette mocked a salamander-shaped district, coining "gerrymander" by blending Gerry's name with the creature.

Both parties have since wielded this tactic for electoral gain, yet media scrutiny only targets Republicans while giving Democrats a pass.

In 2020, Illinois Democrats redrew congressional maps to secure a 14-3 advantage despite controlling only about 60% of the vote. No media backlash ensued. On Aug. 3, more than 50 Texas Democrats fled Austin for Illinois to avoid voting on a Republican redistricting plan that could add five GOP congressional seats. Labeling it a "power grab" and

"racist," they broke quorum, stalling a special session called by Gov. Greg Abbott. Ironically, they sought refuge in Illinois, where Gov. J.B. Pritzker offered lavish hospitality, despite the state's own gerrymandering history.

MRC's study exposes stark media bias: from Aug.

1-6, CNN and MSNBC aired 45 sympathetic interviews with Texas Democrats, but only two argumentative ones with Republicans, both on CNN. MSNBC, with 29 Democrat interviews, ignored Texas GOP perspectives entirely. CNN's Brianna Keilar pressed GOP Rep. Mitch Little on the plan's timing, while Democrats faced softer questions. No Illinois Republicans were questioned on redistricting ethics, revealing a clear double standard in coverage.
