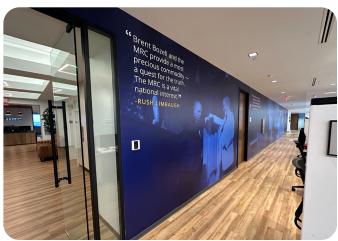

### A LETTER FROM The President

#### DEAR FRIEND OF THE MRC,

In 2024, the Media Research Center didn't just fight we won. Our mission was clear: arm Americans with the unfiltered truth they needed to see through the leftist elite's schemes and make their voices heard at the ballot box. We knew the 2020 election was stolen — not by ballots alone, but by censorship, election meddling, and the relentless anti-American propaganda churned out by Big Tech and their media lapdogs. We vowed it wouldn't happen again. And it didn't.

Donald Trump's victory in November was no accident. It came despite the most lopsided media disinformation campaign we've ever documented — 78% favorable coverage for Harris, just 15% for Trump, a staggering 63-point gap, per MRC's numbers. The press didn't just lean left; it waged war on Trump. Yet he won. Why? Because this time, Americans knew. And they knew because MRC delivered in spades.

We peeled back their deception with methodical work and firm conviction. Using tools that cut through Big Tech's algorithmic sludge, we proved Google had meddled in elections over 40 times since 2008, with Meta and Facebook

hot on their heels — including 2024. Trump took our findings, ran with them on the campaign trail, and vowed to take legal action against Google from the Oval Office. The American people heard him loud and clear.

Before the presidential debate even kicked off, MRC revealed the moderators as Washington's most rabidly anti-Trump journalists. Trump wielded our research like a sledgehammer — calling it out on the debate stage and hammering it home afterwards in the spin room. The whole circus lost its credibility before the first commercial break.

Then there was Kamala Harris's "honeymoon" — the media's nauseating love-fest, showering her with praise while wielding a protective shield of bias by omission. They fawned over her, but MRC ripped the mask off: It was a mirage. Our polling laid bare that three-quarters of Democrat voters had no clue about her radical agenda — supported reparations, dismantling ICE, defunding the police, open borders, and a government takeover of health insurance. Once the truth hit, the honeymoon was over. Done.

And crime? Americans already felt the chaos in our cities, but MRC connected the dots: George Soros was bankrolling soft-on-crime prosecutors, demanding they bow to his far-left playbook. We named names and shone a spotlight. Result? Seven of those DAs went down in flames on Election Day — Los Angeles, Oakland, and even the Georgia prosecutor too cowardly to seek justice for Laken Riley.

By year's end, Trump was bound for the White House, while the talking heads who'd spent years spewing venom — Joy Reid, Katie Phang, Jim Acosta, Norah O'Donnell, and a dozen others — were out on the street. Good riddance.

This wasn't luck. It was you — your belief in MRC and your support — who made it happen. We gave Americans the facts: media bias, moderator bias, search engine bias, Big Tech's dirty tricks. They knew because we refused to let the elites bury the truth.

In 2024, MRC didn't just report the war — we won it. Together.

### Leading the **Movement**

**B**uilding the world's most formidable organization to expose the lies, bias, and censorship peddled by the media, Big Tech, and, far too often, the government itself is a monumental achievement. Seeing it spark real change, landing in the hands of decision-makers who turn it into tangible victories for Americans? That's the MRC magic — and 2024 was our year to prove it.

MRC took on the Department of Defense's funding of leftist media-rating outfits like NewsGuard, which smear conservative voices under the guise of objectivity. With relentless pressure, MRC rallied heavy hitters — Speaker Mike Johnson, Sen. Roger Wicker, Rep. Harriet Hageman, and Rep. Rich McCormick — to our cause. MRC's efforts bore fruit: an amendment to the National Defense Authorization Act prohibiting the Pentagon's partnerships with these far-left firms.

MRC's Censorship Investigation Project blew the lid off of a DHS anti-terrorism grant program, exposing a scheme to push censorship and leftist propaganda into America's classrooms. Working with Sen. Josh Hawley, who, with MRC research in hand, sponsored the "Ending DHS Funding for

Liberal Propaganda Act," targeting the program. MRC boosted the effort through strategic joint letters from Brent Bozell and the Free Speech Alliance to House and Senate leaders.

Speaking of the Alliance, MRC, as its leader, swelled its ranks to 132 members in 2024, welcoming powerhouses like the Center for Fundamental Rights and Digital Privacy Institute.

MRC championed the Free Speech Alliance on Capitol Hill, forging tight bonds with House leaders and committee chairs. Regular meetings tackled the big fights — Section 230 reform, kids' online safety, antitrust enforcement, data privacy, ESG overreach, government collusion, and Al.

MRC's scope went global, too. MRC partnered with the Israeli Embassy to counter skewed media narratives on the Gaza conflict, cementing our international clout.

Back home, MRC led the charge against anti-American billionaire George Soros's bid to purchase Audacy, America's second-largest radio company. Urgent letters to the FCC, penned by MRC President Brent Bozell, spotlighted the freespeech risks, and when the approval slipped through, MRC appealed. Incoming FCC Chair Brendan Carr, an MRC ally, dropped hints of revisiting the sale, suggesting a reversal might be in play.

MRC also played a pivotal role in ensuring children's online safety. It strongly opposed censorship provisions in the flawed Senate version of the Kids Online Safety Act and, in collaboration with Speaker Mike Johnson and House leaders, passed out of committee a House version that opposed censorship while ensuring child safety online.

MRC made strides in its push to defund the Corporation for



Public Broadcasting, sparing taxpayers from funding leftleaning news. After an NPR news editor's essay exposed their "liberal" slant, MRC seized the moment, urging the House Energy and Commerce Committee to hold a hearing. MRC NewsBusters Executive Editor Tim Graham testified, presenting years of research on NPR's (and PBS's) bias.

MRC tirelessly turned its CensorTrack database into "campaign central" for censorship, reaching out to over 1,000 campaign offices across all political parties, plus 50 Big Tech CEOs, warning of swift pushback if candidates were silenced. Separately, the MRC pushed telecommunications CEOs to pledge not to censor via throttling internet service

— a pledge they made and honored, protecting our

elections from this egregious form of censorship.

At the RNC in Milwaukee, not only did MRC dot the landscape with "FIGHT THE LEFTWING MEDIA!" billboards, but the External Affairs department set up 13 interviews for Brent Bozell live from the convention floor on Fox News, iHeart Radio, Breitbart, Daily Signal, and more.

In 2024, MRC didn't just ride the conservative wave — it led it, torch blazing, uniting organizations, influencers, and lawmakers — tackling media bias head-on, amplifying conservative voices, defending free speech, and shaping legislation that matters. 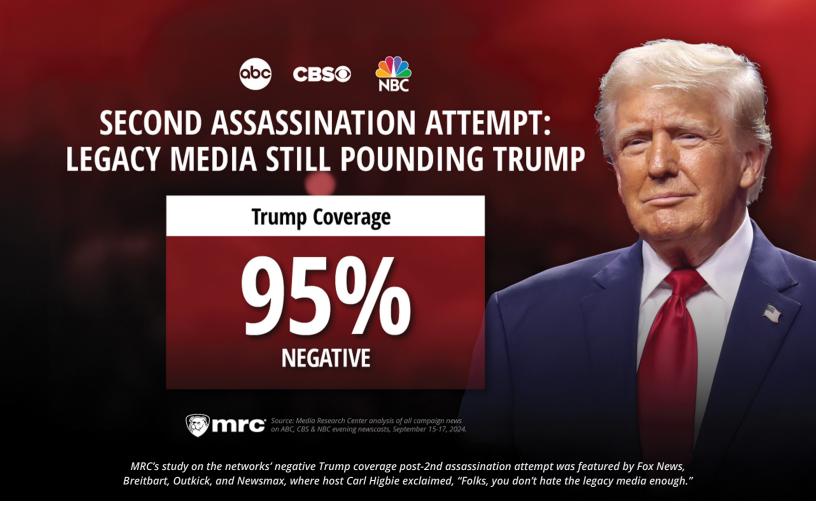

#### ABC Debate Moderator David Muir Hosts 100% Pro-Harris Newscast

An MRC study found ABC's *World News Tonight*, anchored by David Muir — who moderated the presidential debate — was the most pro-Kamala Harris among major evening newscasts, with 100% positive statements about Harris from July 21 to Sept. 6. In contrast, 93% of statements about Trump were negative. Cited on 20+ cable shows, including by Donald Trump in the post-debate spin room, Fox News Channel's Joe Concha called it "Pyongyang ... Moscow 1984 ... Soviet Union," saying even Saddam Hussein likely didn't get 100% positive propaganda coverage.



#### **VP Debate Host CBS Is Wildly Slanted** In Favor of Harris-Walz

With CBS's Norah O'Donnell and Margaret Brennan hosting the VP debate, MRC analyzed 346 minutes of CBS Evening News and CBS Weekend News campaign coverage (161 stories) from July 21 to Sept. 27. MRC found that Kamala Harris received 84% positive coverage and Donald Trump 79% negative. Tim Walz scored 89% positive coverage, and JD Vance 89% negative, exposing CBS's lopsided bias.

#### TV's 2024 Campaign Coverage Most **Biased in Modern History**

MRC's study of broadcast evening newscasts (July 21 - Oct. 25) analyzed 660 campaign stories, revealing that Kamala Harris received 78% positive coverage, while Donald Trump only received a paltry 15% — a massive 63-percentage-point difference in favorable coverage for Harris. Fox Business's Maria Bartiromo called MRC's findings "incredible." Featured eight times on FNC and four on Newsmax, it racked up 118 million social media impressions. Elon Musk shared the study graphic on X, captioned, "Legacy media election interference."

#### **Despite Shooting, the Networks Blast Trump with 95% Bad Press**

MRC's study of the networks' coverage in the 72 hours after the second assassination attempt found 95% negative stories on Donald Trump, such as ABC's Perry Russom on Sunday's World News Tonight calling Trump's remarks about Haitians during the debate, "a baseless claim." MRC President Brent Bozell said, "The legacy media can't stop demonizing Trump, regardless of the cost."

#### MRC Video Busts Media's Harris 'Border Czar/Not Border Czar' Flip

The media gaslit Americans on Kamala Harris's failed border czar stint, flipping from "border czar" to "never was" once she became the Democratic nominee. MRC's compilation video old media clips vs. new denials — hit 8.8 million views. Charlie Kirk ("made by MRC, amazing organization"), Ben Shapiro ("unbelievable cut by NewsBusters"), and Dan Bongino ("hat tip to NewsBusters") praised it alongside Steven Miller, Don Jr., Larry Elder, and Piers Morgan.

#### No Joke: 98% of Late-Night Political Punchlines Aimed at Trump

An MRC study found (Sept. 3 - Oct. 25) that the late-night comedy show hosts told 1,428 "jokes" slamming Donald Trump, a mere 35 poking Kamala Harris. That's a 98% to 2% skew. MRC analyst Alex Christy's work was highlighted on Fox News Channel's *The Five*. Greg Gutfeld noted, "The Media Research Center crunching the data." *Jesse Watters Primetime*, and the popular syndicated show *Inside Edition* also showcased the study.

#### Networks Deliver Massive Media Honeymoon to Kamala Harris

After Kamala Harris joined the presidential race, an MRC analysis of the first month revealed swooning network coverage. Harris netted 66% more airtime than Donald Trump, with 84% positive spin, while Trump's was 89% negative. The study aired on 15 Fox News and Newsmax shows. Mark Levin declared, "The statistics are in from our friends at MRC; they do these great studies." Elon Musk posted the study on X with a "Wow!"

# **EXCLUSIVE MRC POLL: Democrats** in Dark Over Harris' Radical Agenda

To Americans who saw inflation going up and the economy going down, "Bidenomics" was a pejorative. However, an MRC review of CNN's programming from June 17 to Aug. 7 found that 79% of the cable network's "Bidenomics" coverage was positive. It used phrases such as "a lot to be proud of" and "a very, very strong job market" to spin Joe Biden's disastrous economic policies positively.

#### MRC Outs Media's Double Standard: Biden 'Exonerated,' Trump Not So Lucky

After media dubbed Joe Biden "exonerated" on classified documents, MRC's Bill D'Agostino created a contrast video showing the press claiming the 2019 Mueller Report didn't exonerate Donald Trump. It aired on Newsmax's *The National Report*, with Shaun Kraisman saying, "The MRC knocking this one out of the park." Mark Levin said on his radio show, "Our friends from NewsBusters are on top of their game as usual."

# The Soros **Project**

George Soros has been many things to the leftist movement source of its funding, organizer of its censorship, and enabler of its corruption. But on Nov.5, 2024, he became an electoral liability.

That day, three prominent DAs Soros had supported, George Gascon of Los Angeles County, Pamela Price of Alameda County, and Deborah Gonzalez of Athens, Ga., were trounced in their re-election

bids. Gonzalez, who refused to seek the death penalty in the Laken Riley case, lost by 75 points. Price lost her recall election by 30.

In August, MRC released "Law & Dis-Order," a 48-page report revealing that 30% of Americans lived under Soros-funded prosecutors. Our investigation found that these prosecutors agreed to support radical leftist stances on key issues like election integrity, capital punishment, illegal immigration, and property crime in return for Soros's financial backing.

First released as a Fox News exclusive, MRC's influential report played a pivotal role in reshaping Americans' perspectives on crime and safety, paving the way for nationwide triumphs in the process.

George Soros also viewed MRC as a serious obstacle to his election influence schemes. As MRC issued stern warnings to Big Tech firms against censoring conservative voices before the 2024 election, Soros poured millions into efforts to promote those very censorship tactics.

MRC investigated Free Press, a Soros-funded media group that pushed tech giants like Discord, Google, Meta, Instagram, Reddit, and TikTok to escalate censorship before the election. Free Press sent a letter to these platforms, signed by over 200 anti-free speech groups — 45 tied to \$80 million from Soros demanding stricter online content controls.

MRC President Brent Bozell shared these findings on Fox Business's Varney & Co., sparking broad coverage on many news and radio outlets. MRC's explainer video on the subject amassed 300,000 social media views. As it turns out, Big Tech censored far less in 2024 than in the 2020 election. proving they feared MRC's scrutiny more than Soros's cash.

Beyond the U.S., MRC's report exposing Soros-funded media in Hungary seeking to undermine Prime Minister Viktor Orban led to an invitation for MRC VP Dan Schneider to present our findings on Hungarian national TV. Americans and beyond are rejecting Soros's schemes, and MRC's truth-telling deserves the lion's share of credit.

# Fighting Censorship

The left craved a 2020 replay in 2024, but it wasn't happening. The left would have been happy for Google to continue burying search results of Republican candidates and boosting those of Democrats, AI chatbots veering to the left, and significant leftist bias and censorship in media. But MRC wouldn't let them do it. MRC exposed the level of bias in Google's search engines, causing a retreat, a protest, and a threat of legal action by the new president if they didn't reform. MRC flipped the conversation on censorship from "what can we get away with?" to "we better stop." And it's all thanks to your support of our work.

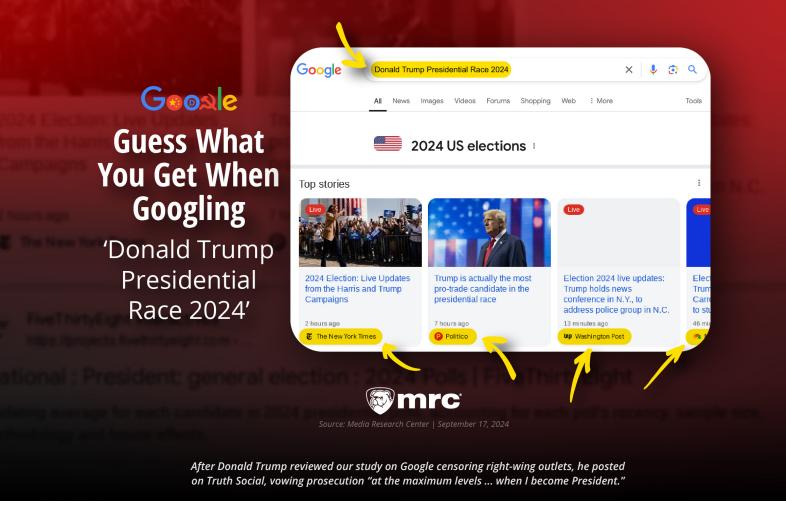

# Trump Vows Legal Action After MRC Uncovers Google Election Interference

MRC discovered last fall that if you typed "Kamala Harris presidential race 2024" or "Donald Trump presidential race 2024" into Google's search engine, you got basically the same response – favorable stories about Harris. Google had either illegally coordinated with the campaign or failed to file disclosure reports, wrote MRC's Dan Schneider in the *New York Post*. Donald Trump threatened legal action after reading it. Even liberal outlets, including *The Washington Post*, *The New York Times*, *USA Today*, and *Rolling Stone*, acknowledged that the MRC study pushed Trump to act.



#### **Dorsey's Shadow Lingers: X Favors Left-Leaning Media Over Right**

MRC research showed Elon Musk still has work to do to make X the bastion of free speech he wants. MRC used Musk's Al chatbot, Grok, to look at the X algorithm, and it found left-wing accounts boosted and right-leaning accounts deboosted or restricted. The story received five million impressions, and Musk read it and vowed to fix the algorithm.

#### **Big Tech Meddled in Elections 80 Times**

MRC made big news with studies showing that Google interfered in elections 41 times and Facebook 39 times since 2008 – Google by favoring leftists and all but blotting out conservatives in its search engine algorithm; Facebook by censoring criticism of Democrat candidates and rejecting ads from Republicans. Both studies made national headlines, and the Google study drew 67 million impressions.

#### Google Up To Its Old Tricks Again

MRC showed not only that Google has been interfering in elections since 2008 but that it was an ongoing project. In all, 19 MRC studies found Google used its search engine dominance to hide positive results for Republicans and amplify Democrat candidates and policies. Google responded that MRC's study focused on "a rare search term on a single day several weeks ago." However, the data and MRC research showed otherwise.

#### CensorTrack Surpasses 7,000 Cases

MRC's CensorTrack.org database of documented cases of Big Tech censorship recorded its 7,000th case on Aug. 5 when Young Americans for Liberty was censored by Facebook for a joke that challenged the global warming narrative. The database includes nearly 700 cases of Big Tech censoring content on behalf of the government because it was critical of President Biden.

# MRC Exposes the Seven Agencies That Censored the Most

Censorship was common across the Biden administration, but an MRC report in June showed that seven departments — Homeland Security, State, Justice, Defense, HHS, Treasury, and the National Science Foundation — led the way. What was worse, MRC's Dan Schneider argued, was that the Biden administration justified the censorship by claiming the government had a First Amendment right to censor citizens.

#### Rep. Jim Jordan Targets Censorship Agencies After MRC Report

MRC's May 2nd report revealed never-before-seen emails showing left-wing outlets like *The Washington Post*, ABC News, and *The Guardian* boosting the disgraced Election Integrity Partnership. Created at the federal government's request, EIP drove widespread censorship before the 2020 election. Following MRC's exposé, House Judiciary Chairman Jim Jordan renewed his urgent call for legislation to defund the censorship agencies fueling EIP's efforts.

# MRC Pushes Google AI Chatbot to Tell the Truth About Israel

Google ceased promoting pro-Hamas talking points about Oct. 7 sexual violence against Israeli citizens, but only after MRC forced its hand. On March 6, MRC Free Speech America found Google's AI chatbot, Gemini, had shifted its stance on whether Hamas terrorists had raped civilians. Initially, it cited "competing narratives," urging consideration of all sides. After MRC pressed Google, a spokesperson admitted the error, promising a swift fix, which it delivered the next day.

#### MRC Uncovers Abuse of Anti-Terrorism Program

MRC released a two-part project that exposed how the Biden administration repurposed an anti-terrorism program to attempt to "inoculate" – their words – kids against conservative ideas and to use taxpayer dollars to promote censorship tools in schools, even paying for anti-Trump blog posts. The House voted to defund the program, and Sen. Josh Hawley made sure it couldn't be purchased for military schools.

MRC's CensorTrack database documents Big Tech's censorship of conservatives, including 204 cases against Donald Trump. Notable examples: On Oct. 28, days before the election, YouTube hindered searches for Trump's Joe Rogan Experience podcast episode. On Sept. 16, Google's Gemini Al chatbot blocked responses about the second assassination attempt on Trump. CensorTrack fueled MRC Free Speech America studies, six of which entered the congressional record during a March hearing. MRC made CensorTrack "campaign central" for censorship, briefing over 1,000 campaign offices across all parties on its findings. Fifty Big Tech CEOs were warned against silencing candidates or face MRC's wrath. Below are three of the hot topics most censored in the MRC CensorTrack database in 2024:

#### **Election/Campaigns 219** Cases

Facebook censored a post slamming Biden-Harris's botched broadband rollout and axed Dan Bongino's clip of Harris pushing censorship incentives. Google buried right-leaning election news, while TikTok deleted comments on fraud and a user noting the Democratic candidate didn't win any primaries.

#### **Immigration**

#### 51 Cases

Instagram nixed a comment on Muslim immigration tied to a UK attack video. YouTube censored a CPAC Hungary "Great Replacement" speech. Facebook nixed Armstrong Williams's Haitian migrant post, and Reddit deleted a critique of illegal immigration's economic toll.

#### **Second Amendment**

#### 21 Cases

Facebook slapped a fact-check on Young Americans for Liberty's post of a Texas 2nd Amendment plaque, suspended Smith & Wesson's page before Black Friday, and restricted Smokin Gun Worx, an Illinois range. Instagram disabled Sig Sauer's shooting community page.



# **Exposing Anti-Americanism**

The left, through media and tech, systematically erodes America's values, traditions, and sovereignty. MRC analysis of PBS News Hour/News Weekend, April 18 through May 23, 2024

A study by MRC on the taxpayer-funded PBS News Hour, which covered 36 days of student protests regarding Israel, found that they labeled the protests "pro-Palestinian" versus "pro-Hamas" 29 to 0.

#### **Pro-Hamas Protests? PBS Says** "Pro-Palestinian" Instead

MRC probed taxpayer-funded PBS's coverage of the springtime campus protests, where pro-Hamas radicals were referred to as "pro-Palestinian. The 36-day study of News Hour/ News Weekend found PBS used "pro-Palestinian" 29 times, "pro-Hamas" zero — soft-pedaling the radicals' virulent anti-Jewish stance. Only two of 28 reports cited the October 7 massacres, just one noted the "From the River to the Sea" chant pushing Jewish expulsion, and none tackled "intifada" calls for violence against Israel.

#### NewsGuard Under Fire: MRC Research **Sparks Funding Ban**

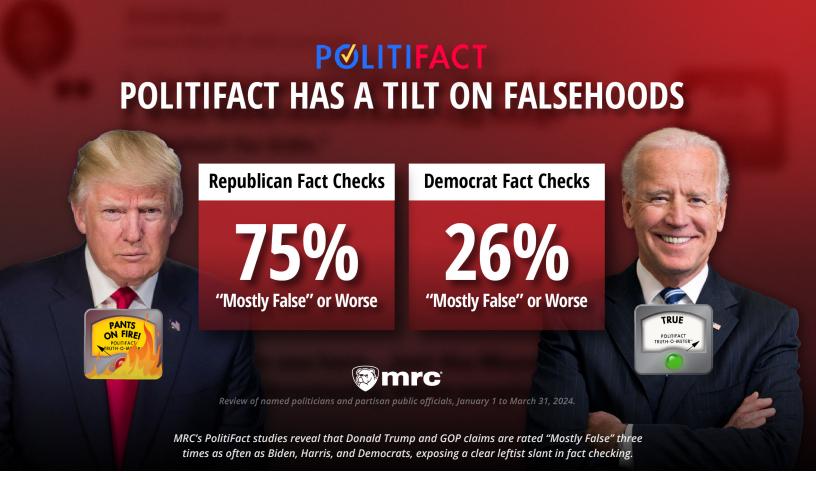
MRC studies continued to challenge NewsGuard, a leftist news ratings firm. In the book The Death of Truth, NewsGuard Co-CEO Steven Brill attributes congressional hearings on the firm's bias against conservative media to MRC's work. Additionally, MRC's research, highlighted in a July hearing with Ben Shapiro, helped prompt House Republicans to bar Pentagon and State Department funding for media ratings firms like NewsGuard and Ad Fontes.

#### **Censoring Conservative Values: Google Buries Pro-Life Outlets**

MRC caught Google red-handed for its bias against prolife conservatives. In January, MRC analyzed search results for "march for life" on the day of D.C.'s annual March for Life event and found Google buried results from pro-life outlets such as Catholic News Agency while promoting leftist sources such as AP and The Washington Post. Google also elevated Planned Parenthood in search results for the term "pregnancy" just before the march.

#### MRC Unmasks CNN's Anti-American Spin, Hannity Agrees

MRC's Nick Fondacaro exposed CNN's defamation of U.S. Navy veteran Zachary Young. CNN's Alex Marquardt falsely labeled Young a "black market" profiteer for rescuing Americans after President Biden's Afghanistan withdrawal. Fondacaro's reporting and exclusive interviews with Young's legal team, following Young's lawsuit against CNN, earned 3.5 million social media impressions. On June 21, Fox News's Sean Hannity featured Fondacaro's post.

# Mainstream Media Ignore Trial of Student Killed by Illegal Alien

On Nov. 22, Fox News's *Hannity* highlighted two NewsBusters studies exposing the media for overlooking the murder trial of Laken Riley, a Georgia student killed by an illegal alien. Curtis Houck's analysis revealed ABC, CBS, and NBC devoted nearly four times more airtime to the Trump comedian "Garbage-Gate" story than to Riley's case. Bill D'Agostino's study showed MSNBC ignored the trial, while CNN gave it just 21 prime-time minutes.

#### Networks Hide Prosecutors' Partisan Ties in Trump Lawfare Trial

An MRC NewsBusters study (Jan. 2023 – April 2024), featured in a Fox News exclusive, revealed ABC, CBS, and NBC evening news buried the party affiliation of prosecutors targeting former President Donald Trump in the Trump Trial. Manhattan DA Alvin Bragg, NY AG Letitia James, and Fulton DA Fani Willis, with a left-leaning DOJ, drove un-American lawfare. Of 417 stories, 90% omitted their party, mentioning "Democrat" just 34 times.

# Brittany Hughes Exposes Gen-Z's Leftist Culture Crisis

A viral Instagram video of a heavily tattooed and pierced Gen Z'er, confused why she didn't get TJ Maxx job, exposed the fallout of pervasive leftist culture from Hollywood, media, and academia. MRCTV Editor Brittany Hughes dissected this indoctrinated mindset in sharp video commentary, spotlighting how it leaves youth lost and ill-equipped. After actor Tyrese Gibson shared the video with Hughes's commentary, it garnered 33.4 million views online.

# Trump vs. Biden: MRC Uncovers PolitiFact's Double Standard

A first quarter MRC study exposed PolitiFact's left-leaning "fact-checking" despite its "nonpartisan" claim. Of 63 Republican fact-checks, only 12.7% were True or Mostly True, compared to 56.4% for Democrats. Donald Trump faced 18 fact checks, none True, with four Pants on Fire ratings; Joe Biden's 12 fact checks yielded six Half True and zero Pants on Fire. Historically, Trump has 187 Pants on Fire ratings; Biden, seven.

### **Defunding PBS & NPR**

#### **Ending the Tyranny of Taxpayer Funding** for Public Broadcasting

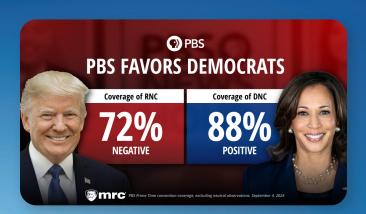
Thomas Jefferson said: "To compel a man to furnish contributions of money for the propagation of opinions which he disbelieves and abhors is sinful and tyrannical." But since 1969, when Congress created the Corporation for Public Broadcasting, and NPR, PBS, and other properties took the airwaves, conservative Americans have been required to do precisely that.

In 2024, American taxpayers chipped in \$535 million to support the CPB.

Since its founding in 1987, the Media Research Center has reminded Americans of this rank injustice. In 2024, our efforts reached a decisive turning point. An NPR editor raised the same concerns about leftist bias that MRC has been raising. This led to a congressional hearing at which MRC's Tim Graham testified about MRC's work documenting bias on PBS and NPR.

The election provided fertile ground for measuring bias, and MRC took advantage. One study found PBS News Hour used the term "far right" 27 times as much as it used the term "far left." Another found News Hour dubbed Donald Trump a "fascist" 17 times but referred to Kamala Harris as a "communist" only three – and two of those were to deny it. Still another found that 88% of PBS's coverage of the Democratic National Convention was positive, but 72% of its coverage of the Republican convention was negative.

DOGE head Elon Musk shared MRC's PBS News Hour "label bias" study with his 220 million X followers.



PBS saved its harshest criticism for the Republican convention such as claiming Trump predicted a "bloodbath" if he lost.



On May 8, NewsBusters Executive Editor Tim Graham testified in a congressional hearing examining accusations of NPR bias.

At the same time, MRC and the Free Speech Alliance, a 130-member First Amendment advocacy group led by MRC, are working to eliminate taxpayer funding for PBS and NPR. MRC is assembling a coalition to mount a persuasion campaign on Capitol Hill and across the country, identify members of Congress to champion the legislation, and, hopefully, bring about the end of Americans being forced to propagate opinions they disbelieve and abhor.

In 2024, MRC produced 359 stories and studies highlighting the persistent left-wing bias at PBS and NPR, along with 18 national TV and radio appearances by MRC experts on this issue.



*In a six-month study, MRC found PBS* News Hour *used negatively* charged "far right" labels 27 times as often as "far left."



The leftist lovefest known as The Pulitzers recognizes the "best" in journalism, but anyone who bucks the progressive narrative goes home empty-handed. Predictably, this year's winners were chock full of archetype ideologues, like *The New York Times, The Washington Post, and LA Times*.

On May 7, MRC presented our 3rd annual Bulldog Awards to honor and celebrate the exceptional work of those in conservative media who the Pulitzers shamefully ignore. MRC President Brent Bozell, "If you want to win a Pulitzer, write about 'climate change' or 'systemic racism' or promote 'Russian collusion.' If you want to win a Bulldog Award, tell the truth. This year's winners are great American truth-tellers"

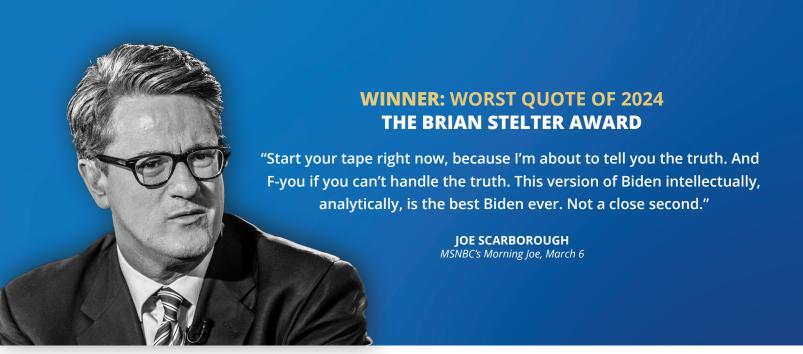

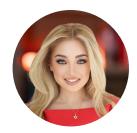

s we reflect on this past year, we remember with profound sadness the loss of David Martin, the Executive Vice President of the MRC, who passed away peacefully on June 12, 2024, after his fifth battle with cancer. David left us far too soon, just a month shy of his 62nd birthday.

I believe it is important for you to know who this remarkable man was and his profound impact on our organization and the conservative movement.

David was not just a leader within our organization; he was also a mentor, a friend, and a guiding light for all of us. He had a way of inspiring people with his words, motivating them with his actions, and instilling in them a sense of purpose and determination. His passion for truth, integrity, and conservative values was infectious, radiating through every decision he made and every project he took on.

I remember in 2008 when I was looking for someone to fill the Executive Vice President position. I had this grand plan: layers of interviews, vetting, character references, and culture fit. This person would be my right-hand man in running the organization. I needed someone I could trust

and with whom I could go skeet shooting on the weekends!

I sat down to interview David first. He was an imposing figure — 6'4", broad shoulders, an even wider grin, and a charismatic intensity — that certain something. Instantly simpatico. I can tell you this: 20 minutes into the interview, I had made up my mind. I dispensed with all formality and said, "Dave — you're hired!" Impulsive but one of the best decisions I've ever made in my entire life.

That was on a Saturday. Even without a formal contract, he was standing at the door of the MRC at 9 a.m. on that Monday, ready to work, having driven four hours from his home in Pennsylvania to be there. In his role, David managed day-to-day operations, oversaw finances and fundraising, and embodied the role of chief administrator, ensuring the smooth running of the various departmental



functions. He excelled in the stewardship of the organization with military precision. I could always count on David. He never once let me down.

For 16 years, he guided the MRC to heights I wasn't sure we could reach. As the President and Founder, I typically receive accolades and credit for leading the group. I hire good people. That's the key to my success — and MRC's success. And there was no better hire than David. He deserves every bit of credit for MRC's accomplishments, if not more. Yes, more.

He is what I would call a man's man — firm grip, steely eyes, bold, a man of intensity — but for good reason. He expected results. "Give me your best," he would say. Quite frankly, we were afraid not to!

But beyond his professional achievements, David was a man of unrivaled passion for the things he loved. Above all, his love for his wife, Sherry, and his immense pride in his daughters, Marissa and Trista, were evident in every aspect of his life.

A former college basketball player, David enjoyed talking hoops — and the times he dunked on someone. He was proud of that. However, to know David meant understanding his absolute dedication to our constitutional right to bear arms.

His gun collection was a wonder to behold — every make and model, some dating to the Old West. David embodied a sense of security and loyalty. If ever the MRC was under assault by leftist ne'er-do-wells, I knew — everyone knew we could seek solace and protection behind David Martin.

There is much to say, but I'll leave you with this. A few years

ago, we were looking for a new billboard campaign, a snappy slogan to represent what we do here. Without missing a beat, David told me, "Believe in America, not the Media."

Perfect.

That wasn't just a PR pitch from David; it represented his belief system. It came from his heart and soul. His love and admiration for this nation and its cherished principles permeated every aspect of his being, sparkled in his eyes, and resonated in his actions. David's commitment to our cause was resolute.

I am a better man for knowing David Martin. MRC is a better organization. The conservative movement is stronger. The world is a better place. While we mourn the loss of such an extraordinary individual, we also celebrate his incredible life. David leaves behind a powerful legacy and a challenge for all of us to continue his work and never waver in our principles or pursuit of truth.

Your contributions empowered him to fight for his beliefs, for which we remain eternally grateful. As we move forward, we continue to keep David's family in our thoughts and prayers. God rest his soul, and Lord, thank you for bringing David Martin into our lives. He's now your right-hand man.

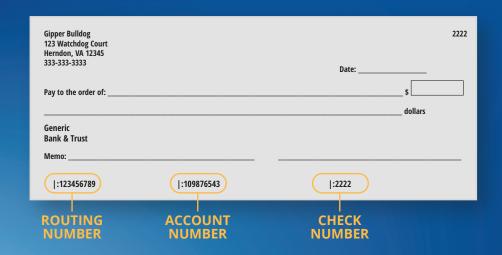
